PLEASE READ AND TAKE ACTION

Paul Chalker and I today met with Ian Aldridge and Jason Mahoney from Goulburn Mulwaree Council regarding a Traffic Management Plan for the Park.

The following was decided:-

The Gates at Rex/Dewhirst will remain closed as we had previously agreed and advised all clubs and the only entry to the Park will be by Race Course Drive.

However the parking area near Dewhirst Street will remain open and access to it will be via Race Course Drive and through the Park. This is a concession by GMC as they wanted the Park closed to parking near the present slip rail.

To help manage the through traffic near the Tractor Shed/Slip Rail the roadway will be narrowed so that only one car can pass at any one time. This should make it safer for Players/Parents going to the Under 6 Fields.

There will be a Spectator Gate entrance off Dewhirst Street.

Parking will be allowed in Race Course Drive near the Race Course Club House.

The Gate near the Under 10 – 11 Fields will remain closed and **NO PARKING WILL BE ALLOWED IN RACE COURSE DRIVE NEAR THIS AREA.**

The Dewhirst Street Gates will be closed from and including Saturday 10 April 2010 which is our first lot of games for this year.

Please inform all your Players and Parents of this arrangement and ask them to inform other People of the new arrangements

Also Players/Parents need to give themselves an extra 10-15 minutes to get to the Park.
